RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. No horse or pony to compete more than once in any one class.
2. There will be a timed section for all classes – optimum time not speed.
3. Riders must report to the collecting ring 10 minutes before their start time
4. The organizers reserve the right to refuse an entry, cancel a class, withhold a prize or disqualify a competitor for any reason they deem necessary. Competitors failing to obey the instructions given by the Fence Judges, Stewards, judges or other officials will be disqualified.
5. Hard hats to the correct British standard must be worn, properly adjusted and fastened, at all times when mounted. Body protectors and Medical Armbands are compulsory. Hunting Jackets or cross country colours may be worn. Cameras on riding hats may NOT be worn. Riders MAY NOT USE THEIR OWN BIBS.
6. The Judge's decision is final. Any objections or protests must be handed to the Secretary, in writing, with a deposit of £10 within 10 minutes of the results being published. The deposit will be retained if the objection not upheld.
7. Part entry fee refunded only on production of a vet's/doctor's certificate.
8. No Farrier on call – Please ensure your Horse / Pony is well shod.
9. Dogs must be kept on a short lead and under control at all times. Young children must be supervised at all times.
10. Horses and ponies must not be left unattended in the lorry park unless secured correctly inside a trailer/horse box. Stallions only by prior agreement.
11. Age as at 1st January 2017
12. After 3 refusals at one fence a rider may continue at the discretion of the fence judge, but must not in any way impede other competitors.
13. Competitors who receive first aid treatment may only continue if the Medic considers they are fit to do so.
14. Any horse/pony jumping Hors Concours must remain so for the rest of the event.
15. Please respect the hospitality of the Landowners and take your litter home. Do not clean out your horsebox/trailer in the field.
16. In the event of cancellation £10 will be retained from each entry to defray expenses incurred.

Legal Liability: No responsibility can be taken for the theft, loss, damage, accident or illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles attending this event.

Health, Safety & Welfare: The organizers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organizers and all Officials and Stewards.
